## **Complaint Procedure**

## Licensure Disclosure - Dental Hygiene

The Associate of Applied Science in Dental Hygiene, if successfully completed, meets the licensure requirements for a Registered Dental Hygienist license in New York. As part of the program, students are required to take and pass the National Board Dental Hygiene Examination (NBDHE) and the Commission on Dental Competency Assessments examination (CDCA).

Graduates of the Dental Hygiene program, when they obtain a license in the state of NY and travel to another state, can be licensed either by credential or examination depending on each state's requirements. Every State Board of Licensure is governed by its own State Board of Dentistry, and state

laws/board rules can and do change from time to time. It is recommended that all enrolled and prospective students contact their state's licensure entity to review current licensure requirements. This disclosure is not a guarantee of approval of any application for licensure in any state.

At this time, all 50 US states and territories recognize the NBDHE exam and 47 of 50 states and territories recognize the CDCA exam for initial licensure. The following states do not accept the CDCA as a pathway to initial licensure:
